

SCC Proposal D – Removal Clean-up

Amend Bylaw 5.1.2.13

Adopted by Committee 6/1/19 (9-0-3)

Explanation: When the Bylaw language governing the removal of party officials was updated during the 2018 State Convention, the new language inadvertently left out proper verbiage, creating a run-on sentence.

SCC Proposal D would insert language that was inadvertently left out of Bylaw 5.1.2.13, eliminating the run-on sentence.

5.1.2.13 Remove by two-thirds (2/3) vote of those attending for good cause, and after two (2) weeks' notice and hearing, any duly elected or appointed party official, including any officer of the NDP, Congressional District Organization, County Party officer, Central Committee Member, Affiliated Caucus Organization, standing or ad-hoc Committee Member, at any level of the Nebraska Democratic Party who has failed to attend the duties of his or her office, who publicly opposes the election of a Party nominee for local, state or national office, who has violated any Code of Conduct adopted by the State Central Committee, who is abusive of their authority, or **who engages in** other misconduct that calls into question their fitness for office. Publicly opposing a candidate from whom State Party resources have been withheld under Bylaw 7.3 shall not constitute grounds for removal;
