End Transphobia Resolution

Whereas: Transphobia leads to the senseless deaths of beautiful human beings, destroys families and relationships;

Whereas: The Transgender community is among the most vulnerable across the various marginalized communities, especially trans women of color;

Whereas: Transgender equality lags far behind the rest of the LGBTQIA+ Community;

Whereas: A higher proportion of trans people are victims of violence compared to the rest of the population;

Therefore be it resolved, that the NDP stand firmly in support of ending transphobia.

Be it further resolved, the NDP stand against violence against trans people as well as violence against all marginalized communities.

Be it further resolved the NDP consider helping in the creation of a state level committee for gender identity issues to help give trans and gender nonconforming persons a safe space and an area of concentration in a Democratic organization that may not always be respectful enough of gender identity issues.
