Approved June 19, 2016 NDP Convention

Be it resolved - We support the renaming of Nebraska counties that were named after individuals who killed native Americans in military action. These counties would include but not limited to: Boone, Custer, Cherry, Howard, Sheridan, and Wayne.

Be it further resolved - we recommend to rename Howard County to Skidi County which is the Pawnee name of the indigenous group that resided there prior to Nebraska statehood.

We support the renaming of Sherman County on the basis that General Sherman did not support African American equality during the civil war. He also advocated for the eradication of the American bison population which would result in the starvation of the indigenous populations of the Central Plains region.
