Resolution Calling for National Unity, Defense of Democratic Norms, and Resistance to Executive Overreach Sponsored by: Chuck Riedelsel, LD30

WHEREAS the United States is experiencing unprecedented threats to constitutional norms, democratic institutions, and the rule of law under the current President;

WHEREAS actions by the President, including threats of retribution, disregard for truth, the undermining of international alliances, and the use of divisive rhetoric, have eroded public trust and national unity;

WHEREAS the spread of misinformation and fear-based tactics has fostered xenophobia, weakened public health responses, and damaged scientific, educational, and social institutions;

WHEREAS Nebraska's Congressional delegation has not taken sufficient action to uphold and defend the Constitution in the face of these developments;

WHEREAS the Democratic Party, along with other civic and political groups, must recognize the seriousness of this moment, which goes beyond typical partisan disagreements;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nebraska Democratic Party calls for a unified and nonpartisan response. This includes cooperation with members of the Nebraska Republican Party and other civic institutions to speak honestly to the public about the ongoing threats to democratic principles;

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nebraska Democratic Party supports initiating constitutionally appropriate actions, including impeachment proceedings if justified. The Party urges elected officials to resist executive overreach through all legal and peaceful means;

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nebraska Democratic Party will commit to building trust, fostering understanding, and encouraging reconciliation among all Nebraskans regardless of political affiliation. This is based on the belief that Nebraskans share common values, hopes, and goals;

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution will be printed and sent to the Nebraska Federal Delegation.
