

# Nebraska 2nd Congressional District Redistricting Talking Points

All On The Line is committed to supporting a fair redistricting process that achieves fair maps in Nebraska. In order to advocate for the fairest maps possible, there are three major messages that must be communicated effectively:

# Omaha should remain whole within the 2nd congressional district

 There is a large African-American/Black population in Omaha, which is currently whole within the 2nd congressional district and should remain whole in that district to avoid diluting these voters' voices.

# Suburban Bellevue should be reunited in the 2nd congressional district

• Prior to the 2010 redistricting cycle, the suburban areas of Sarpy County were part of the 2nd congressional district. Reuniting suburban Bellevue with the 2nd district would allow the 2nd district to return to an almost entirely urban and suburban seat.

# Western, rural Sarpy County should be moved to the 1st congressional district

 Rural Sarpy County (west of Richfield) is currently in the 2nd congressional district but should be moved to the 1st congressional district, which is already a rural seat. Western Sarpy County would be a better fit for the rural communities currently in the 1st congressional district.

#### The congressional map proposed by Vice Chair Justin Wayne achieves all of these goals.
