NEW Options to Start SCC Meeting:

After many conversations and reflection, we are putting in place a process to start our State Central Committee members that respects Democrats of faith and Secular Democrats.

As an SCC Delegate, you have three choices to start the first 5 minutes of the meeting.

Please complete the form for your room choice by Sept. 30 at 5pm CT -- for those that do not complete this form by that date, we will place you in the No Option room.

In the Prayer room, Vice Chair Pastor Banks and Interfaith Council Chair Weber will lead who is chosen to give prayer. In the Secular room, Secular Democrats Chair Walter will lead who is chosen to speak.

We will ask this before every SCC Meeting for those Delegates who may want to choose a

different option at each meeting. When we are back in-person, we will have physical rooms people can self-select.

For Delegates who get seated on the day of, the link is also sent to Alternates so we should have their choice already recorded.

We do ask for patience the first time we try this technology. We've talked with experts who use Zoom often and are confident this will work for us.



Resolutions Committee Submissions: If you want to submit a resolution for consideration, please contact the Resolutions Chair Shirl Mora James by email platform@nebraskademocrats.org

- Any proposed resolution must be submitted to the Resolution Committee Chair 10-days ahead of the SCC meeting (therefore for this meeting the date is September 21st, 2021 at 1 p.m. CT).
- The committee then reviews and votes on resolutions. The committee can take various actions when they submit their report to the SCC.
 - 1) We can approve the resolution out of committee (as is or with some suggested edits) and bring it to the floor of the SCC for a vote. We will hand out the proposed

resolutions for SCC consideration in a packet at the Registration desk. When we are meeting online, the links will be included in the SCC Meeting packet.

- 2) We can reject a resolution and we will inform the submitter of this decision. A SCC member can then bring the resolution to the floor with a majority vote of the body to hear the resolution.
- 3) We can recommend the resolution to a committee.

By Law Reference: "5.10.1.1.4. Resolutions. At each State Central Committee meeting, the Platform and Resolutions Committee shall submit a report of those resolutions timely submitted to the committee for consideration by the State Central Committee. The committee's report to the State Central Committee shall include the proposed resolutions recommended for adoption, those forwarded without recommendation, those recommended for consideration at the next biennial State Convention, and a list of those not recommended by the committee."

Tips and Tricks for Submitting a Resolution to the NDP:

- Research the resolution's topic. Make sure what you want to propose does not conflict with the Platform and other passed Resolutions.

- Write your resolution to be free of spelling and grammatical errors. Shorter resolutions are better. Whereas paragraphs should be descriptions. The resolved paragraph sets out the actions you want taken.
- The Platform Committee needs to receive a writable document (non-PDF, non-hard copy) sent to one or both designated email addresses, even if the resolution comes from the floor.
- Please be sure to designate who will present the Resolution and speak in favor of it, if you are unable to attend the meeting.
