The Nebraska Democratic Party's Executive Committee voted to move forward with submitting our state for the pre-window of the presidential nominating calendar.

Nebraska is in the ***middle of everywhere*** — with a mix of urban, suburban and rural voters along with an inexpensive media market — providing candidates a real opportunity to break through with grassroots campaigning that builds the party.

The businesses in Omaha, the military base in Bellevue, the university in Lincoln, the Tribal Nations, the historic black community, the growing Latino and immigrant communities, and the family farms and ranches in rural Nebraska can help candidates shape a message to bring back voters, not just for our state, but in other “red and rural” states that we need for the critical U.S. Senate, governor, and state legislative races.
