Note 1: Because exit polls are rarely conducted in Nebraska, representation goals for ethnic and racial minority groups (African American, Hispanic, Native American, & Asian/Pacific Islander) were calculated using 2021 Census Population Estimates, American Community Survey 5-year Estimates, and voter registration totals according to the Secretary of State as of 2/24/23. These calculations also utilize national 2018 Pew Research polling which shows that African Americans, Hispanics, and Asian Americans are registered as Democrats at a higher percentage than the overall electorate, and 2022 Brookings Institute polling showing the same for Native Americans.
