

How to Serve as a Nebraska Delegate to the 2024 Democratic National Convention

Step 1

VOTE in the 2024 Democratic Presidential Primary on May 14th.

Step 2

Attend your County Convention (Held between May 18th and 28th) and declare your presidential preference.

Step 3

Be elected as a delegate or alternate to the State Convention at your County Convention.

Step 4

Fill out the Declaration of Candidacy to the National Convention and return to the NDP. Forms will be available on the NDP website starting April 26, 2024 and must be submitted NO LATER THAN May 31, 2024 at 5 p.m.

 Note: Presidential campaigns have the right to approve the lists of delegates and may remove applicants for any reason, providing that they approve a certain number of candidates for each delegate slot.

Step 5

Attend the State Convention on June 7-9, 2024 in Hastings to be elected as a Delegate to the National Convention in Chicago in August 2024

- Please Note:
 - You must vote in the 2024 Presidential Primary in order to run for National Delegate.
 - You MUST have completed a delegate application form and turned it in by the deadline to run for National Delegate.
 - While you do not need to be a state delegate to be eligible to run for National Delegate, it is highly advised.

Key Dates:

- Primary Voter Registration Deadline -online April 29, in person May 3, 2024
- Primary Election May 14, 2024
- County Conventions May 18-28th
- Declaration of Candidacy April 26th May 31st 5pm deadline
- State Convention June 7-9 in Hastings
- National Convention August 18-23 (including travel, actual convention is Aug 19-22)

Total Nebraska Delegation- 34 Delegates & 2 Alternates

20 District-Level Delegates and 2 District-Level Alternates

- Allocated to each of Nebraska's three (3)Congressional Districts (see chart below)
- A presidential candidate must get 15% or more of the vote in the district to receive any delegates.
- Gender must be balanced within each delegation when selecting delegates, with non-binary individuals not counting against either men or women.

6 At-Large Delegates -

Elected statewide - viability and gender balance rules apply.

3 Party Leader & Elected Official (PLEO) Delegates

- Mayors of major cities, State Senators, and other elected officials are eligible to run for these positions, they must follow the same guidelines as other delegates.

5 Automatic Delegates

- Chair Kleeb, Vice Chair Kaminiski, Committeewoman Ligon, Committeeman Flowerday, and DNC Member Dunixi Guereca.
