The Ben Nelson Gala will be held at the Hilton Omaha (same venue as SCC) on the evening of Friday, November 7th. Doors will open at 5 pm due to security. Ballroom doors will open at 6 pm, and the program will begin at 7 pm.

- <u>Ben Nelson Gala Tickets</u>: As of Oct. 29, we only have about 20 overflow room tickets left. The speakers will come into that room to say hello.
- Clear Bag Policy: We will enforce a small clutch-sized or clear bag policy at this year's Gala. A small bag, approximately the size of a hand, with or without a strap, can be taken into the ballroom. These clutch bags must not be larger than 4.5" x 6.5", and clear bags must not exceed 12" x 6". No book bags, no large purses. No signs will be allowed.
