Welcome to Norfolk for the 2026 Nebraska Democratic Party's State Convention. Home of Johnny Carson, lots of corn, homegrown wind power, and the Elkhorn River. We gather this weekend to conduct our party's business and to build our infrastructure so we can keep electing strong Democrats who represent our values.

Since 2017, we have grown from 503 to 1,029 Democrats elected across our state. We have raised roughly \$1 million a year. Our county parties have grown from under 40 to 71 across the state. Our staff is professionalized and unionized. Candidate recruitment is strong and coordinated with allied groups.

Some write Nebraska off as a flyover state. We know better. We sit at the heart of this country — the middle of everywhere — and we are growing a movement rooted in community, powered by conversation, and driven by one unshakeable belief: every Nebraskan deserves a fair shot.

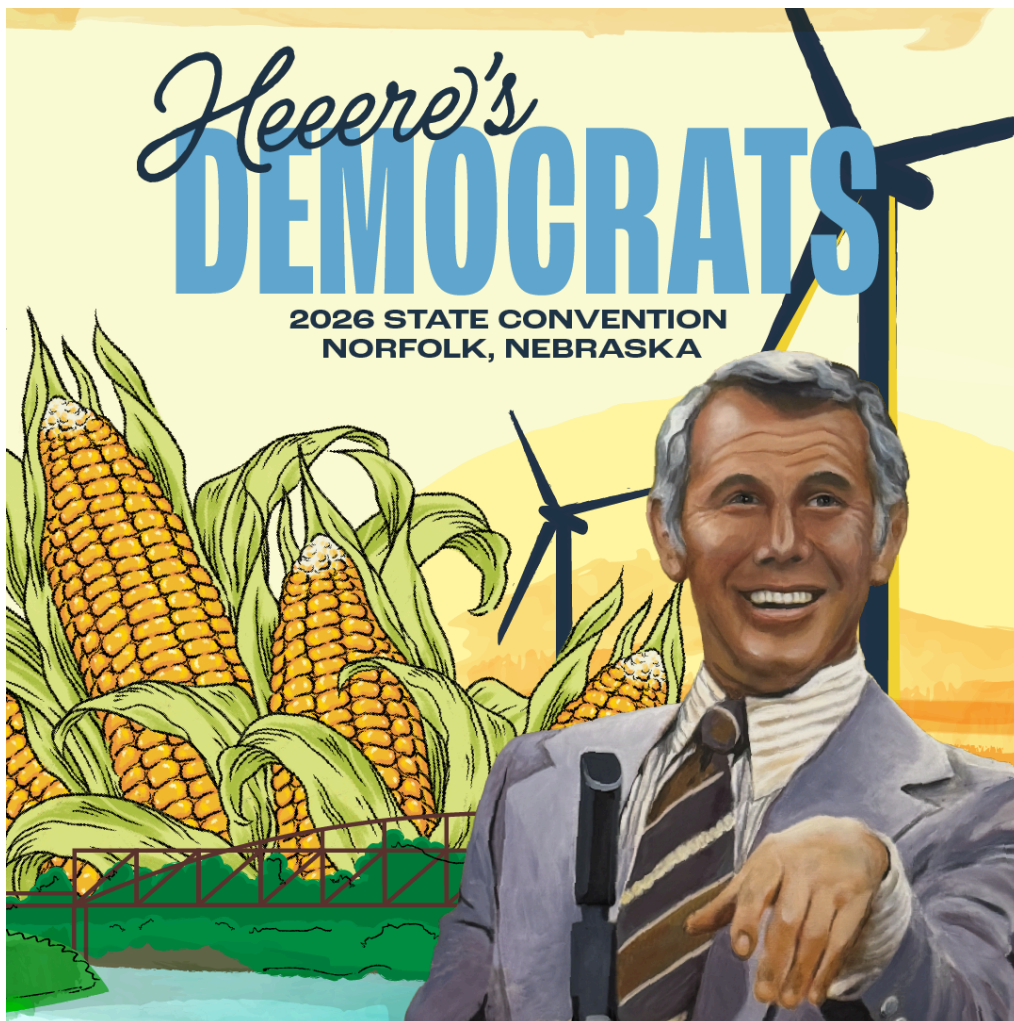

Convention FAQ:

We know it can be confusing for those attending your first State Convention to know exactly what takes place!

We conduct the business of the Nebraska Democratic Party and our Affiliated Caucuses and Councils at the State Convention, which takes place every two years. Between the State Conventions, we hold at least four State Central Committee meetings each year, during which training and business are conducted.

- **Submit a nomination for statewide officer positions (only the Chair, Vice Chair, and Chair of County Parties positions are up this year):**
 - Send an email about your intention to run to the chair of the Nominations Committee, Roger Morgan, at nominations@nebraskademocrats.org. The Nominations Committee will meet at 6:00 PM on Friday, April 24th, in the Veranda Room.

- **Run for a Caucus or Council leadership position:**

- **Submit a platform plank:**

- **If I am not a Delegate or Alternate to the State Convention, can I still attend the State Convention and Caucus meetings?**
 - Yes, you may attend the State Convention. Only Delegates (or an Alternate filling in for a delegate) may vote during the State Convention proceedings (general sessions, Congressional District Caucuses, and Legislative District Caucuses). But you can observe the State Convention as a guest as long as you are a Democrat or an Independent. However, each Caucus and Council has their own requirements on who can be voting members. You **MUST** be a Democrat to vote in Caucus and Council meetings and abide by any other rules.

- **How much does it cost to attend the State Convention?**
 - There is no cost to attend for elected delegates and alternates.

 - Guests who are Democrats and Independents are welcome to attend for free, but seating is limited. Everyone must register on-site, and party registration will be checked.
