

# Resolution in Support of the Nebraska Workers and the Initiative to Increase the Minimum Wage

Adopted by the Nebraska State Convention on April 25, 2026

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Democratic Party supports and recognizes the right of workers to earn a living wage;

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Democratic Party supports and recognizes the right to a living wage applies to all, regardless of age;

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Democratic Party endorsed Initiative 433 in 2022, which raised the minimum wage for all workers in Nebraska and provided for future minimum wage increases;

WHEREAS, the voters of Nebraska overwhelmingly supported Initiative 433 by a margin of 386,756 in favor to 272,603 opposed at the general election on November 8th, 2022, as part of a successful statewide vote;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nebraska Democratic Party reaffirms our support of the voter passed Initiative 433 raising the minimum wage;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Nebraska Democratic Party disavows and condemns the Legislature's passage of LB 258 on February 5th, 2026;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Nebraska Democratic Party thanks the sixteen Senators who voted against LB 258 on Final Reading;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Nebraska Democratic Party stands in continued support of raising the minimum wage, including any repeal of LB 258;

AND BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Nebraska Democratic Party calls upon all candidates and elected officials to recognize the right of all persons to earn a living wage.
